MECHANICAL TRADE OVERVIEW

Heavy Vehicle and Plant Mechanics test, diagnose, repair and maintain industrial and heavy mobile equipment. This includes regular maintenance and upkeep of:

- Engine systems
- Transmission systems
- Final drive systems
- Fuel injection systems
- Suspension systems
- Hydraulic systems
- Pneumatic systems
- Auto electrical systems
- Electronics systems
- Steering and braking systems


Equipment within the Tutt Bryant Group can include trucks and specialised trailers, cranes, elevated work platforms, compaction machinery, excavators, loaders, crushing and screening equipment and stationary plant such as generators, compressors and pumps.

- Diagnose mechanical and electrical faults by utilising troubleshooting knowledge learnt through your apprenticeship including interpreting and utilising hydraulic and electrical schematics, operators and parts manuals both electronically and hardcopy
- Effectively utilise test equipment to assist with diagnosis
- Testing, commissioning, and pre-delivery of new machinery sales
- Workshop based and Field Service tasks
- Fabrication and repair of components utilising correct techniques
- Carry out detailed repair reporting for all plant and equipment records as per legislative requirements

FAQs

How often do I need to study?

The chosen RTO that we engage at Tutt Bryant release about 4- 6 training blocks during the year which you will be required to attend.

Will work ever clash with my studies?

No work will be sperate to your studies. You will be given time away from the workplace to attend the RTO chosen and attend studies.

What happens if I fail a subject in my studies?

The RTO will arrange a re-sit of the theory test otherwise you will be required to complete the module again at a time they can accommodate.

Do I need to pay for this apprenticeship?


No all RTO and training costs will be covered by the Tutt Bryant Group.
